Summary of Pupil premium spend for 2019 to 2020

Barriers to educational achievement that the disadvantaged children face: Some of our pupils in receipt of pupil premium have low attendance and/or fall into the category of persistent absence. Some families have struggles with accommodation, with local rents and home prices now at record high points. Some children have poor language development. A number struggle with reading fluency and comprehension.

Targeted reading Intervention groups	£64,160	To provide additional support for pupils in reading. To run interventions to narrow the attainment gap for vulnerable pupils.	Evaluation will focus on academic gains and the extent to which the school is closing the attainment gap between disadvantaged pupils and their peers.
Attendance and punctuality	£3,000	To ensure pupils are able to access their learning.	Better attendance and punctuality will improve a child's attainment.
Resources	£2,000	To ensure pupils are able to access their learning	Quality resources to improve attainment.
After school and Saturday interventions	£14,000	To provide additional support for pupils in reading, writing and maths.	Evaluation will focus on academic gains and the extent to which the school is closing the attainment gap between disadvantaged pupils and their peers.
